

Content for the Template for Sexually Active Children Contraception Template

Excluding Child Sexual Exploitation

Question 1

Establish whether the children is already sexually active and in what circumstances is the sexual activity occurring and with whom.

- "Excluded sexual activity under 13" or "Sexual activity under 13 (report)"
- "Excluded sexual activity with a person in a position of authority" or "Unlawful contact (refer)"
- "Free text box"

Question 2

Have you ever stayed out overnight or longer without permission from your parent(s) or guardian?

- "Yes / No"
- "Free text box"

Question 3

How old is your partner or the person(s) you have sex with? (Is the age difference 4 or more years?)

- "Enter any declared ages"
- "Free text box"

Question 4

Does your partner stop you from doing things you want to do?

- "Yes / No"
- "Free text box"

Question 5

Thinking about where you go to hang out, or to have sex. Do you feel unsafe there or are your parent(s) or guardian worried about your safety?

- "Yes / No"
- "Free text box"

Question 6

If there is potential that a sexual crime is being committed against a child a referral to the police is a professional obligation.

- "Yes / No / Need to discuss with the practice lead for safeguarding"
- "Free text box"

Fraser Guidance

Criteria 1

The girl (although under the age of 16 years of age) will understand his advice

- "It is in the best interest to give contraceptive advice"
- "Criteria not met to issue"

Criteria 2

They cannot persuade her to inform her parents or to allow him to inform the parents that she is seeking contraceptive advice

- "Asked to discuss with her parents"
- "Criteria not met to issue"

Criteria 3

She is very likely to continue having sexual intercourse with or without contraceptive treatment

- "Patients' health is at risk with contraception"
- "Criteria not met to issue"

Criteria 4

She receives contraceptive advice or treatment her physical or mental health or both are likely to suffer

- "Patients' health is at risk with contraception"
- "Criteria not met to issue"

Criteria 5

Her best interests require the clinician to give the patient contraceptive advice, treatment or both without the parental consent

- "It is in the best interest to give contraceptive advice".
- "Criteria not met to issue"
